#### It's Not Too Late to Mitigate Your 2020 Illinois **State Income Tax Liability**

We need your help through additional donations! So far this year we have only received donations to make awards to 18 students.

Please consider making a donation to the Invest in Kids Scholarship Program. You will benefit from the state tax credit and the students will benefit from the tuition assistance.

Through the Invest in Kids Act, Illinois children from low-income households have access to a new scholarship program that can provide up to 100 percent of their tuition and fees to attend a Catholic school.

These scholarships are funded by donations made by individuals and corporations to Empower Illinois, the Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) that represents the Catholic schools in the Diocese of Peoria.

### HOW DOES IT WORK? An Example:

A Taxpayer Donates \$1,000

Individual donor designates the Catholic Diocese of Peoria Schools or a specific school as the beneficiary.

The \$1,000 gift becomes a student scholarship

The donation becomes \$1,000 in targeted scholarship funds.

The taxpayer claims a \$750 credit on their 2020 Illinois state income tax bill

The taxpayer receives a credit on their state income tax bill equal to 75 percent of their gift.

A student receives an excellent Catholic education!

Children receive an outstanding Catholic education that their families previously thought was unattainable.
