
### John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.


Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under the heading Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply at: https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is April 26, 2024. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

For Kindergarten: Students must be 5 years old on or before 09/01/2024.

Birth Certificates for New students: Official copy is needed - not hospital issued.


### Required exams:

Physical Exams: The state of Illinois requires a current physical, with up -to -date immunizations, for all students entering Preschool, K & 6th grade.

**Dental Exams**: Dental exams are required for students in K, 2nd & 6th grades.

Eye Exams: Required for Kindergarteners only. The exam must be from an eye doctor, not your family doctor or pediatrician.

All exams must be turned in to the school office by the first day of school.
