#### Friday, October 3, we will celebrate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi.


The feast commemorates the life of St. Francis, who was born in the 12th century and is the Catholic Church's patron saint of animals and the environment.

On Friday, October 31, our primary grade children (K - 3rd grade) will have a Halloween celebration. The children may bring school appropriate costumes [weapons and costumes of a violent nature are to be avoided) and change shortly before their parade. Starting at @ 1:10 p.m. the Kindergarten children will parade through the 1-3 classrooms. K - 3rd grade will go to the gym to parade for parents who wish to come.

The Parade for Parents will begin @ 1:20 p.m. in the gym. In order to avoid congestion in our hallways, ALL parents are asked to come to our gym between 1:10p.m. - 1:15 p.m. for the parade. Please enter the school through the gym door entrance, which will be open @ 1:10 p.m., and go directly to the gym.

Parties for grades K-8 will start at 1:30 p.m. in their classrooms and will conclude @ 2:15 p.m. to allow time for an end-of-the -day wrap-up with the children before the 2:30 p.m. dismissal. We are requesting that parents leave the classrooms at 2:15 p.m.! In order to promote greater security and safety for our children, we also ask that parents **NOT** take students from the classroom at 2:15 p.m., but wait for them to be dismissed at 2:30 p.m. Your cooperation and support is appreciated!

## **End-User Instructions**

#### Getting Started:

- Go to https://Peoria.cmgconnect.org/
- 2. Create a new account by completing all the boxes under the Register for a **New Account** area. This includes your address, primary parish, and how you participate at your parish or school. If you have questions please contact your parish/school coordinator.
- 3. Your dashboard will show you the required and optional training curriculums that have been customized for your particular role within the Diocese.
- 4. Click under the Safe Environment Training-Peoria to begin.
- 5. On the last page of the curriculum, submit your background check information. The curriculum will be marked "Resume" until your background check is processed and reviewed by the diocese. Processing can take up to 7-10 business days.
- 6. If needed, you can access your completion certificate after you are certified by returning to the training dashboard and clicking **Print Certificate**.

If you have expired, you must take the RENEWAL Training – complete the background check and CANTS at the same time. These are uploaded – do not print and send to the office. Follow the prompts to submit.





