

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Outdoor Recess:

Students should be encouraged to engage in physical activity during recess year round...including winter--unless temperatures are dangerously cold or when it is raining. Every child, unless excused by reason of ill health, is expected to comply to the outdoor guidelines set at St. Thomas. Please keep in mind that winter air does NOT cause or worsen minor symptoms as long as children are dressed appropriately. Extended indoor recess requests require a doctor's note.

Guidelines

Students will be outside at all recesses when the temperature (including wind chill) is 15 degrees or above and it is dry. Temperature is checked throughout the day during cold weather.

Students need to dress adequately for cold weather by wearing coats that close, hats or ear bands, pants or tights/ leggings, and mittens or gloves. Students will also be required to stay within the designated areas to avoid unnecessary wetness. Students may bring boots to wear for warmth, however, playing IN the snow during recess is not allowed.

End-User Instructions

Getting Started:

- 1. Go to https://Peoria.cmgconnect.org/
- Create a new account by completing all the boxes under the Register for a
 New Account area. This includes your address, primary parish, and how you
 participate at your parish or school. If you have questions please contact your
 parish/school coordinator.
- Your dashboard will show you the required and optional training curriculums that have been customized for your particular role within the Diocese.
- 4. Click under the Safe Environment Training-Peoria to begin.
- On the last page of the curriculum, submit your background check information.
 The curriculum will be marked "Resume" until your background check is processed and reviewed by the diocese. Processing can take up to 7-10 business days.
- If needed, you can access your completion certificate after you are certified by returning to the training dashboard and clicking **Print Certificate**.

If you have expired, you must take the RENEWAL Training – complete the background check and CANTS at the same time. These are uploaded – do not print and send to the office. Follow the prompts to submit.
